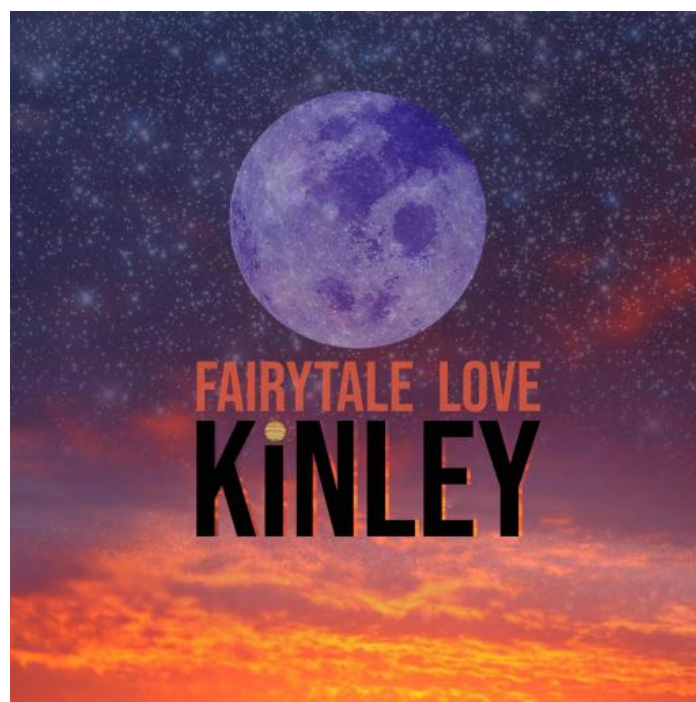

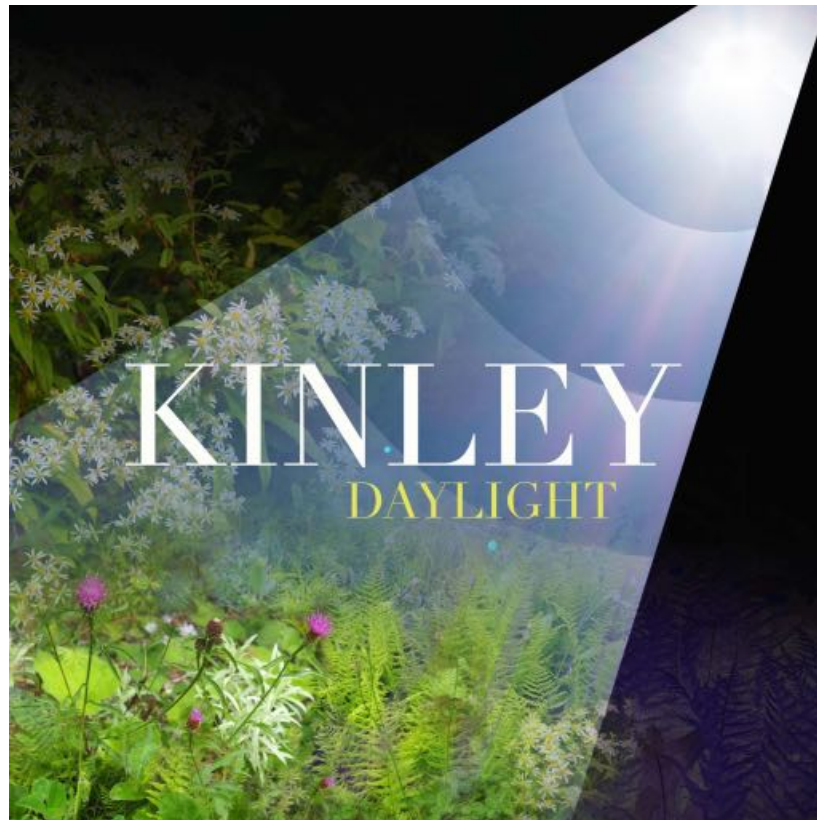

(October 7, 2022 – Toronto, ON) – Today, P.E.I Indie Pop Powerhouse and former **Hey Rosetta!** member **KINLEY** has released the lush and dreamy new single “Fairytale Love”. Listen [HERE](#). “Fairytale Love” is the third and final song to preview KINLEY’s forthcoming studio album ***Daylight***, which will be released independently on **November 4, 2022**. The album’s artwork and track listing have now been revealed and can be found below.

“Fairytale Love is about analyzing the relationship you’re in and noting all the things that aren’t working. It’s not even close to the fairytale love you’d imagined having, so you walk away to hopefully find the romance of your dreams. (But life is about lessons and the idea that you were meant to be together just for a short time is a fact of life),” shares KINLEY about her latest single.

Featuring **The East Pointers' Jake Charron** on guitar, synths, keyboards and beat production, "Fairytale Love" follows the upbeat, sun-soaked perfect summer single "Sweet Oblivion" and the catchy, emotive lead single "Eiffel Tower". Featuring harmonious violin and viola, and infectious sing-along chorus and lush back-up vocals from Toronto's **Maia Davies** and Saskatchewan's **Janaya McCallum** (Jay & Jo), KINLEY recently released a lyric video for "Sweet Oblivion", which can be viewed [HERE](#). KINLEY's latest solo effort, *Daylight*, is a masterclass in musical dynamism, flowing effortlessly from tropically tinged indie pop to affecting folk to driving dance music and much in between, drawing influence from past projects but with a newfound energy and earnestness. Having shared countless stages and recording credits with some of Canada's best-known artists since her teens; KINLEY has adapted that approach into her solo work - and is delivering the most compelling material of her decorated career.

Daylight, follows KINLEY's critically praised, statement making self-titled sophomore album and her 2016 renowned debut *Letters Never Sent*. KINLEY's sophomore release, which amassed three Music PEI Awards and two ECMA Award nominations, features the stunning "call to action" single "[Lightworkers](#)", highlight single "[Run With You](#)"; which was featured in PEI Tourism's 'Islandness' ad and winner of the very first 'Women's Freedom Song Contest', the empowering "[Washington](#)".

Letters Never Sent also garnered three *Music PEI Awards* and two *East Coast Music Awards* and featured the raw and deeply powerful lead single "Microphone". The [video](#) for "Microphone" went on to inspire an entirely new sexual health curriculum in P.E.I; with focus placed on consent, gender norms, bystander intervention and sexual assault for all grade 9 Health classes.

With advocacy being a central and important part of her life, KINLEY is working with The PEI Rape and Sexual Assault Centre to implement what has now been termed the 'Island Shot' in bars and restaurants around PEI to help address the amount of uninvestigated drink spikings that are happening in Charlottetown. "*The idea behind the 'Island Shot' is similar to the 'Angel Shot' that started years ago in the UK but we wanted to put a local slant on it,*" shares KINLEY. The 'Island Shot' is something that a patron can order to let staff at a bar or restaurant know that they feel unsafe. A passionate endorser of this initiative, KINLEY's efforts have helped to create further awareness for the "Island Shot" with posters being placed in the majority of bars in Charlottetown as well as liquor stores across PEI. KINLEY, who began hosting virtual violin lessons during the pandemic, recently made her music instruction book titled '*Violin with KINLEY*' available via [Amazon](#). Designed to accompany the digital version available through <https://www.violinwithkinley.com>, the physical edition includes 42 violin pieces to play at weddings, cocktail hours or just for fun. The book also includes scales, tips, definitions and QR codes to link to YouTube for extra support.

A successful and prolific musician, KINLEY has put in her time as a member of beloved East Coast collective Hey Rosetta!, her later pairing with cousin Liam Corcoran of Two Hours Traffic as The Express, plus stints and studio sessions with the likes of Kathleen Edwards, Fortunate Ones, Rose Cousins, Jenn Grant, Laurent Bourque, Madison Violet, David Myles, and Matt Mays, to name a few.

Since her solo breakout, she's earned multiple ECMA and Music PEI Awards, had songs propel major ad campaigns, and used her growing popularity and platform to draw international awareness to causes close to her heart – particularly those focused on women's rights and prosperity, becoming a community leader and revered public voice in the process.
