Anchored by its title track—an Irish pub ballad featuring acoustic guitars, pounding drums, and haunting fiddle—the EP showcases the incredibly talented artist's blend of classic blues, country, and

rock. It delivers a stunning showcase of rich storytelling, powerful emotive vocals, and Emmett's anthemic western spirit.


At just 24 years old, Emmett Jerome is carving out a place in the hearts of roots music fans with his deep authenticity, and striking sonic maturity. Inspired by the masters of Americana and blues—artists like **Chuck Berry**, **Brian O'Brien**, and **John Martyn**—Jerome imbues his work with a distinct voice that reflects his personal journey and connection to Canada's western landscapes.

Hailing from the rugged terrain of Alberta and now rooted in Vancouver, Jerome's music reflects a life spent traversing Canada's vast roads. *Rocky Mountain Son* is a collection of Emmett's reflections on adventure, struggle, and resilience, all while paying homage to the wide-open roads and towering mountain ranges that shaped him.

"I wrote *Rocky Mountain Son* as a way to distill the traveling vagabond time of my life into something I could look back on," shares Emmett. "It became a guiding light for the project." "This record is about embracing my roots and reflecting on the years spent as a musician travelling Canada. I wanted the music to feel as expansive and authentic as the places I've lived, and the people I've met."

Featuring his signature acoustic guitar work, title track "Rocky Mountain Son" joins the EP alongside previous singles "Goodbye Trouble" and "Coquihalla Prayer". The former offers a reflective take on loss, with its blend of country and psychedelic guitars, while the latter is an homage to the rugged road life, inspired by classic Canadian artists like Corb Lund and lan Tyson. These tracks, alongside the new offerings, round out an impressive collection, and powerful first impression for Emmett Jerome.

"'Rocky Mountain Son' was inspired by my transition to living in rural Alberta and coming out West to BC," says Jerome, speaking on the title track. "I spent a couple of years cutting my teeth as a musician travelling lots and meeting some amazing people. I wrote the song as a signifier of what this project meant to me."
