(Toronto, ON - March 21, 2025) Rising Toronto alt-rock trio **Stuck on Planet Earth** have revealed the official music video for “**Erase Me**”, their chart-climbing first radio single of 2025. Directed by award-winning Canadian filmmaker [Travis Nesbitt](#) (**Royal Tusk, Tim & The Glory Boys, Brett Kissel**) and starring **Lena Anderson** and **Daria Strelnikova**, the video for “Erase Me” showcases raw, hypnotically alluring visuals that amplify the song’s exploration of lust, desire, loneliness and emptiness, vividly bringing its themes to life. **Watch the “Erase Me” video [HERE](#).**

“The *Erase Me* video had to have a certain feel and we knew Travis was the one to bring it to life,” shares the band. “His street-style approach in directing, paired with sharp flash photography, captured the grit and edge we wanted. The result is a neon-lit, reckless, and provocatively alluring performance that perfectly matches the song.”

"Erase Me", which follows last fall's R&B infused alt-rock gem "["Slow Dancing"](#)", has taken the talented trio to new levels in Canada, from gracing **Amazon Music's** billboard at Sankofa Square to being featured in multiple **CBC** and **Sportsnet Hockey Night in Canada** clips, as well as, a coveted feature in one of the 4 Nations Face-Off tournament games.

"At its core, "Erase Me" is a song about lust and the desire to be with another woman and erase the past to move forward only to feel empty," shares vocalist and bass player **Al Capo**. "This song explores the exhaustion of living in a limbo state, unsure of what the future holds for a relationship. It deals with the idea of being with someone, even if just for one night, to break away from loneliness. It's about wanting to feel something new after all the hardships of the separation and not wanting to take it seriously, rather just fulfilling basic human needs."

Stuck on Planet Earth consists of **Adam Bianchi** (vocals and guitar), **Al Capo** (vocals and bass), and **Andrew Testa** (drums). Known for their captivating live performances and unvarnished and utterly honest musical approach to songwriting, their 2020 critically acclaimed debut album **Beautiful Nowhere** debuted at #4 on the Canadian Digital Album Chart and has amassed over 4 million streams globally.

With 86k Shazams, the album's impact continued to grow through its Top 30 singles "Ghosts on the Radio" and "Higher Than the Drugs," which remained on the Canadian Billboard Rock Charts for 10 consecutive weeks. Additionally, three of the album's singles hit the Top 10 in Italy, reaching over 4 million daily radio audience impressions and the band landed a cameo performance on the Netflix series *Sex/Life*. Their 2023 single "Crack In The Glass" was propelled by a successful TikTok influencer campaign, generating over 10 million streams on the platform.
